# PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

## Welcome Fr. Joe!

Our new assisting priest Fr. Joseph Catanise brings a wide range of pastoral experience to St. Rita's. Fr. Joe has ministered at the parish level as an associate pastor and a pastor. He has been a college chaplain at two of our area colleges, and chaplain at Rochester General Hospital.

Fr. Joe was born in Waterloo, N.Y. and attended public schools there. He received his B.A. and his Juris Doctorate degrees from Syracuse University. Fr. Joe taught at St. Mary's School for five years before becoming a lawyer. He practiced law for two years in Seneca Falls, N.Y. and then entered St. Bernard's Seminary. At St. Bernard's, Fr. Joe received both a Master of Divinity degree and a Master of Arts in Theology. Fr. Joe also studied in Rome, Italy, for two years.

Fr. Joe has served in many areas of the Diocese - Elmira, Auburn, Greece, Brockport, Rochester, Dansville - and now "Where life is worth living".

His interests include travel and immersing himself in different cultures, collecting antiques, gardening, reading, and studying history and current events. He is involved in the Cursillo Movement and the Charismatic Renewal.

He is an avid Buffalo Bills fan, and he roots for his alma mater Syracuse University.

Fr. Joe is hard of hearing and has a cochlear implant. He has learned sign language (although not 100% fluent) and can sign the Mass. Because of his own journey into deafness before his implant, he is very knowledgeable of Deaf Culture.

Fr. Joe likes to tell really bad jokes, so we at St. Rita's will just have to suffer through them.

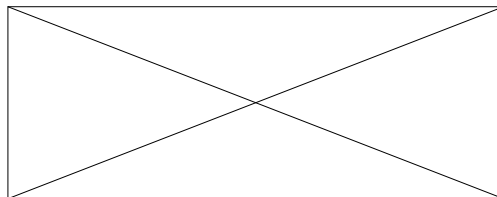
**SAVE THE DATE!**
